-Los **colores** en inglés son **adjetivos**:

(Azul)

(Rojo)

(Cafe)

(Naranja)

Gold

(Dorado)

Black

(Negro)

Grey

(Gris)

White

(Blanco)



Grammar: Adjectives/ Singular & Plurals

-El **color**, siempre va antes del **objeto** al que describen.

-En **singular**, se le agrega **A** antes del **color**:

Ejemplo:

A blue jacket. (*una chamarra azul*)

-Cuando una palabra termina en **-s**, el **objeto** ya es **plural** y **No** se utiliza **A**:

Ejemplo:

Blue Jeans (*jeans azules*)

Grammar: Wearing vs Have On

-Para **describir vestimenta**, utilizamos las siguientes frases:

-I'm **wearing**

Ejemplo:

I'm **wearing** **blue** **jeans**. (*estoy usando jeans azules*)

o

-I **have on**

Ejemplo:

I **have on** **a** **black** **shirt**. (*traigo puesta una camisa negra*)

She ***is wearing*** brown boots and blue jeans.



2

He ***has on*** a black jacket and a grey t-shirt.



Grammar: Wearing vs Have on (3rd person)

-Para *describir la vestimenta de los demás*, utilizamos *He/She* (el o ella):

-is wearing

Ejemplo:

He **is wearing** blue jeans. (él está usando jeans azules)

o

-has on

Ejemplo:

She **has on** a black shirt. (ella trae puesta una camisa negra)
