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# Vocabulary: Possessive Adjectives

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**I-My dress**  
(Mi vestido)



**You-Your jeans**  
(Tus jeans)



**He-His tie**  
(Su corbata)



**She-Her high heels**  
(Sus tacones)



**It-Its sweater**  
(Su sueter)



**They-Their t-shirts**  
(Sus playeras)



**We-Our jackets**  
(Nuestras chamarras)



**You-Your sunglasses**  
(Sus lentes)



# Grammar: Possessive Adjectives

-Utilizamos los **adjetivos posesivos** antes del **objeto** para *indicar a quién le pertenece*:

(**sujeto** + **be** + **adjetivo posesivo** + **objeto**)

Singular: **This** **is** **my** shirt. (*está es mi camisa*)

Plural: **These** **are** **her** shoes. (*estos son sus zapatos*)

-El **sujeto** de las oraciones son los **demonstrativos**:

(**This, That, These, Those**)

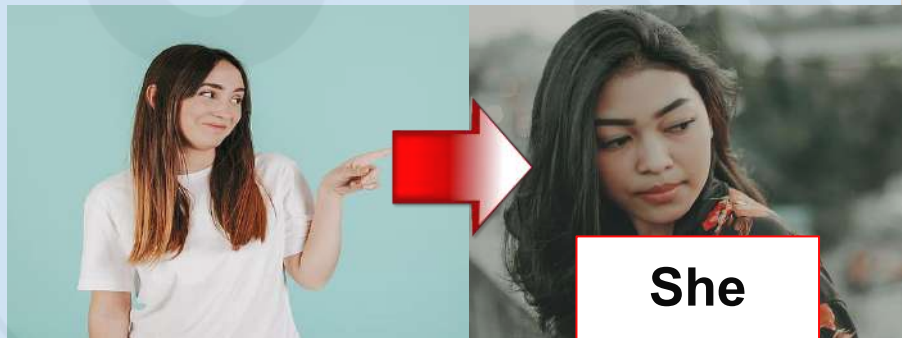

# Grammar: Possessive Adjectives

-En **negativo**, utilizamos las contracciones de **Be + Not:**

**isn't** (singular) / **aren't** (plural)

Singular: That **isn't** your shirt.

(esa no es tu camisa)

Plural: Those **aren't** his shoes.

(esos no son sus zapatos)

# Vocabulary: Possessive Pronouns

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**I-Mine**  
(*Mio*)



**You-Yours**  
(*Tuyo*)



**He-His**  
(*de el*)



**She-Hers**  
(*de ella*)



**It-Its**  
(*de eso*)



**They-Theirs**  
(*de ellos*)



**We-Ours**  
(*de nosotros*)



**You-Yours**  
(*de ustedes*)



# Grammar: Possessive Pronouns

-Utilizamos los **pronombres posesivos** al final de la oración para **indicar a quién le pertenece el objeto**:

(sujeto + objeto + be + **pronombre posesivo**)

Singular: This hat is **mine**. (está gorra es mía)

Plural: These jeans are **hers**. (estos jeans son de ella)

-El **sujeto** de las oraciones son los **demonstrativos**:

(**This, That, These, Those**)

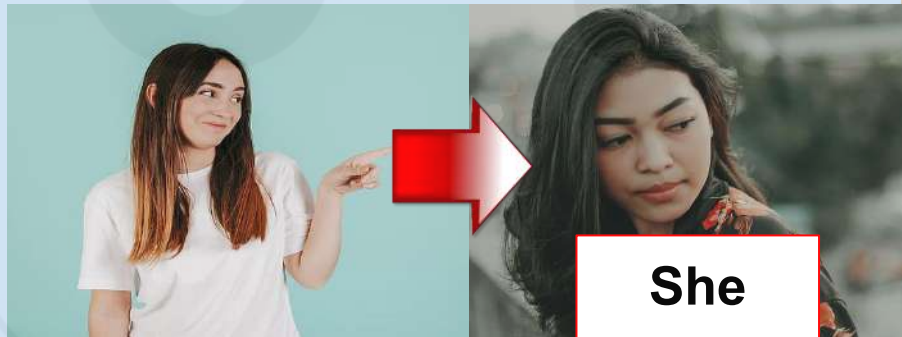

# Grammar: Possessive Pronouns

-En **negativo**, utilizamos las contracciones de **Be + Not:**

**isn't** (*singular*) / **aren't** (*plural*)

Singular: That hat **isn't** yours.

(esa gorra no es tuya)

Plural: Those jeans **aren't** his.

(esos jeans no son de el)



## Task 14. (*isn't*) or (*aren't*)



1. This bracelet --- ***hers***.



2. These shorts --- ***yours***.



3. Those jeans --- ***mine***.



4. That wallet --- ***his***.





# Grammar: Possessive Adjectives

-Para *preguntar*, utilizamos el verbo **Be**:

-Para **Adjetivos Posesivos**:

(**be** + sujeto + **adjetivo posesivo** + objeto?)

Singular: **Is** this **your** shirt? (¿esta es tu camisa?)

Plural: **Are** those **your** jeans? (¿esos son tus jeans?)



# Grammar: Possessive Pronouns

-Para **Pronombres Posesivos:**

(**be** + sujeto + objeto + **pronombre posesivo**?)

Singular: **Is** that shirt **yours**? (¿esa camisa es tuya?)

Plural: **Are** these jeans **yours**? (¿estos jeans son tuyos?)

2. --- these *your* ties?



3. --- those glasses *mine*?



4. --- that watch *his*?
