## Grammar: Possessive Case 'S 1

-En *inglés*, utilizamos un **apóstrofe (-'s)** cuando usamos el **nombre de la persona** para decir que el **objeto le pertenece**:

(sujeto + be + nombre + -'s + objeto)

Singular: This is Juan's shirt.

(*está es la camisa de Juan*)

Plural: These are Carla's shoes.

(*estos son los zapatos de carla*)

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## Grammar: Possessive Case 'S 2

-Cuando **el nombre termina con -s**, solo agregamos el **apóstrofe**:

(sujeto + be + nombre + (-') + objeto)

Singular: This is Andres' shirt.

(*está es la camisa de Andres*)

Plural: These are Carlos' jeans.

(*estos son los jeans de Carlos*)

-These are --- dresses.

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**-This is --- tie.**

**-This is --- purse.**

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## Grammar: Possessive Case 'S 3

-Cuando tenemos **2 nombres**, solo al último nombre le agregamos **-s**:

(sujeto + be + nombre 1 + and + nombre 2 + **-s/-** + objeto)

Singular: This is Juan and Ramon's shirt.

(*está es la camisa de Juan y Ramón*)

Plural: These are Carla and Iris' jeans.

(*estos son los jeans de Carla y Sofía*)



## **Task 9. Whose sweatpants are these?**

**-These are ---

***Sofia & Ana***

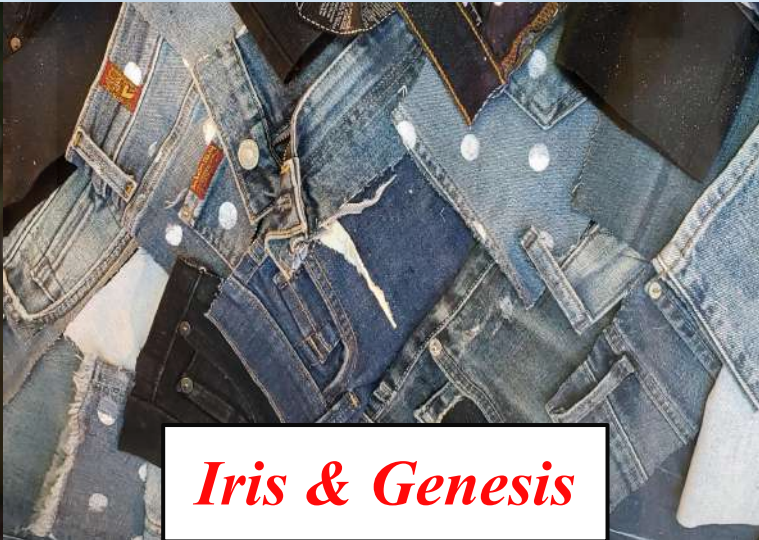






## ***Task 11. Whose jeans are these?***

## Grammar: Possessive Case 'S

-Para *preguntar si algo le pertenece* a cierta persona, utilizamos el verbo **Be**:

(**be** + sujeto + nombre + **'s/-'** + objeto?)

Singular: **Is** that Ramón's shirt?

(¿es esa la camisa de Ramón?)

Plural: **Are** those Carlos' jeans?

(¿son esos los jeans de Carlos?)



## **Bonus: (Is) or (Are)**



1. --- that **Ana's** skirt?



2. --- those **Ulysses'** boots?



3. --- those **Iris** and **Sofia's** rings?



4. --- that **Ramon's** necklace?
