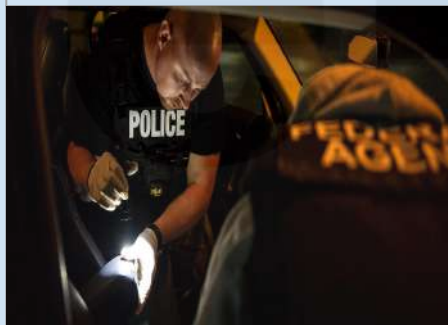

Grammar: Modal Verb Can (3rd person)

-El **verbo modal Can** en **tercera persona** **No** cambia el **verbo**:

(A + sujeto + **can** + verbo + objeto)

Ejemplo:

A teacher **can** teach English.

(un maestro sabe enseñar inglés)

-Utilizamos el **artículo A** para decir (**un** o **una**).

-What can a doctor do?

-A doctor --- --- people.



Task 2.

-What can a pilot do?

-A pilot --- --- a plane.



Task 3.

-What can a farmer do?

-A farmer --- --- food.



Task 4.

-What can a waiter do?

-A waiter ----- food.



Task 5.

-What can a police officer do?

-A police officer --- --- criminals.



Task 6.

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-What can a mechanic do?

-A mechanic --- --- cars.



Task 7.

-What can a lawyer do?

-A lawyer --- --- people.



Task 8.

-What can a nurse do?

-A nurse --- --- patients.



Grammar: Modal Verb **Can't** (3rd person)

-El **verbo modal** **Can't** en **tercera persona** tampoco cambia el **verbo**:

(A + sujeto + **can't** + verbo + objeto)

Ejemplo:

A teacher **can't** build homes.

(un maestro no sabe construir casas)

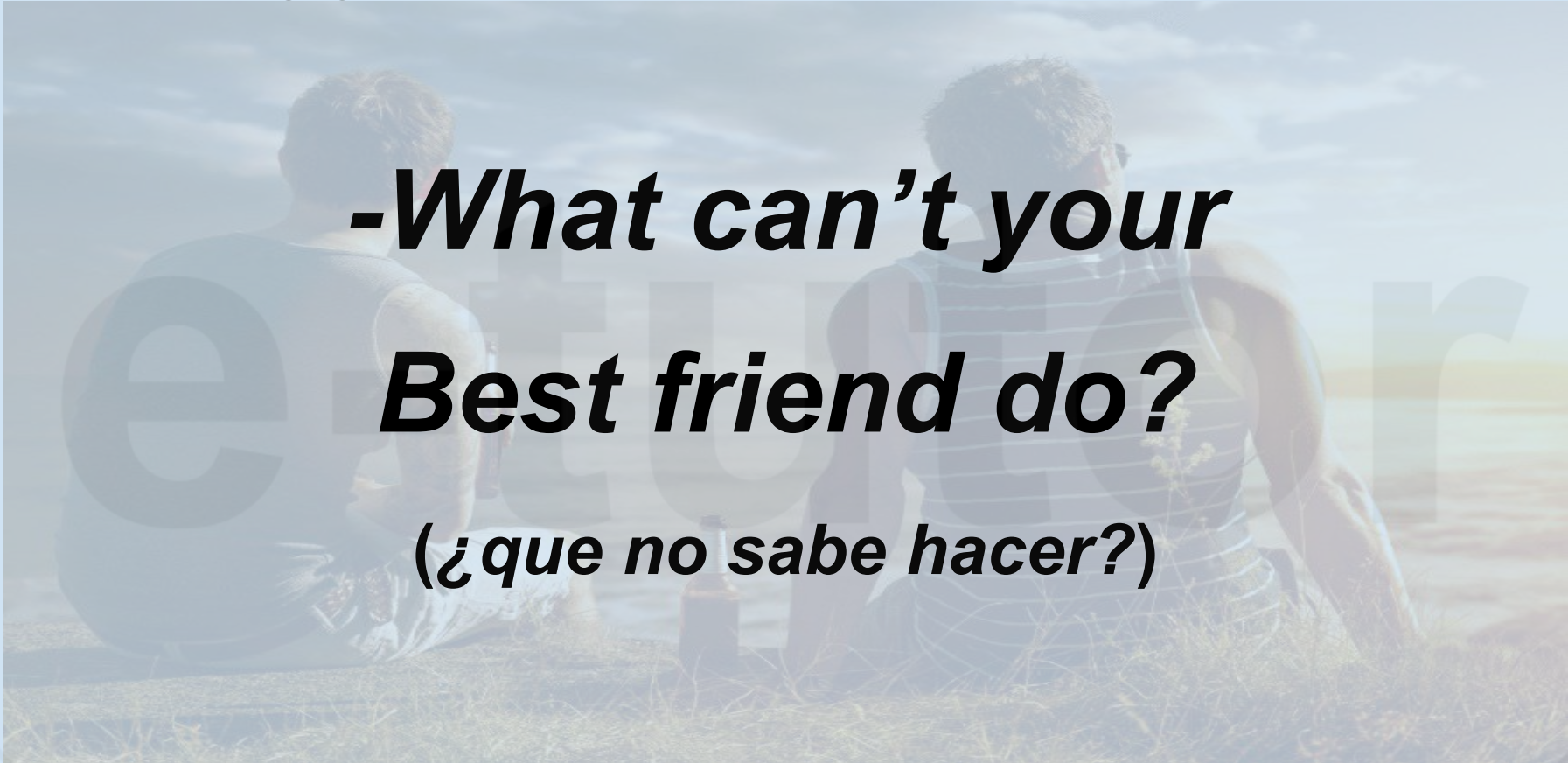
