Language in Action: Meal Times.

I **have** fried eggs with bacon
for breakfast.



2

I **have** a sandwich or a salad
for lunch.



3

I **have** soup or beef stew
for dinner.





Grammar: Have vs Eat

-El verbo **Have** se utiliza cuando *hablamos de comida preparada* en una *hora específica*:

(sujeto + **verbo** + comida + hora de comida)

Ejemplo:

I **have** scrambled eggs for breakfast.

(desayuno huevos revueltos)

-**Eat** se utiliza cuando *hablamos de comer en general*.

-Aunque: los podemos intercambiar sin cambiar el significado.

Grammar: Verbs Like & Love

-Para **expresar que algo nos gusta**, utilizamos los siguientes **verbos**:

Like (<i>me gusta</i>)		Love (<i>amo</i>)	
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(sujeto + **verbo** + (**to eat**) + comida)

Ejemplo:

I **like to eat** scrambled eggs.

(*me gusta comer huevos revueltos*)

-Cuando utilizamos el **verbo Love**, **No** utilizamos (**to eat**).



Task 4.

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-What do you like to eat?

-I like to eat ---.



Task 5.

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-What do you love to eat?

-I love ---.



Grammar: Verbs Don't Like & Hate

-Para **expresar que algo No nos gusta**, utilizamos los siguientes **verbos**:

Don't Like (no me gusta)		Hate (odio)	
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(sujeto + **verbo** + (**to eat**) + comida)

Ejemplo:

I **don't like to eat** scrambled eggs.

(no me gusta comer huevos revueltos)

-Cuando utilizamos el **verbo Hate**, **No** utilizamos (**to eat**).

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***-What don't you like
to eat?***

-I don't like to eat ---.



Task 7.

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-What do you hate to eat?

-I hate ---.



Grammar: Likes & Dislikes (3rd person)

-Para la *tercera persona* (**He/She**), utilizamos:



Likes, Loves



Doesn't like, Hates

Ejemplos:

(My dad) He **likes to eat** fried beans.

(a el le gusta comer frijoles)

(My mom) She **hates** beef stew.

(ella odia el caldo de res)

Grammar: Verb Do

-Para **preguntar** si les gusta comer alguna cosa,

utilizamos el **verbo Do** o **Does**:

(**Do/Does** + sujeto + like + comida?)

Ejemplos:

2nd Person: **Do** you like ketchup?

(¿te gusta la catsup?)

3rd Person: **Does** your dad like ketchup?

(¿le gusta la catsup a tu papa?)
